

SHW Access for Remote/Online Low-Residency

Students who pay a Reduced Health Fee Students engaged with Brown via online, low-residency or study away (U.S. based) programs pay a reduced health fee each semester. For the 2025-2026 academic year this is \$118 per semester. Due to licensing regulations governing our clinicians there are limits to the provision of clinical care across state lines. Please review the document below for clarity on when/how you can access services from Student Health and Wellness when paying the reduced health fee. Student Health and Wellness includes the following five offices: Brown Emergency Medical Services, BWell Health Promotion, Counseling and Psychological Services, Student Accessibility Services, and Student Health Services.

Students who pay the reduced health fee can access the following services ONLY while on campus in Rhode Island during in-person program components:
